FACTS	WHAT DOES THE CASEY AUTOGROUP DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies chose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number, personal income and employment history • Account balances and payment history • Credit history and credit scores
How?	All financial companies need to share customer's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Casey Auto Group chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Casey Auto Group protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Casey Auto Group collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personnel information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply for a lease or apply for financing • Pay us by check or give us your contact information • Show us your driver's license <p>We also collect your information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates and other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your credit worthiness • Affiliates from using your information to market to you • Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account unless you tell us otherwise.

Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial or nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our affiliates include companies with Casey Auto Group
Non-affiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial or nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nonaffiliated we share with include banks, finance companies, insurance companies, and direct marketing companies.
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Casey Auto Group does not jointly market
